

Fiji Ports Update

Dear Valued Customers,

Further to our notice on the 23rd March regarding of the closure of the Port of Lautoka, we would like to provide an update based on events since.

The Ports of Suva & Lautoka are now both open and we are taking cargo bookings to & from these ports for import & export cargo. Bear in mind that there is still a quarantine zone around the city of Lautoka and so movement of cargo in & out of this zone are still restricted until the 7th of April. This situation is being reviewed regularly by local authorities.

Since 0500hrs this morning, due to new cases of Covid-19 in the area, the city of Suva is also now a quarantined zone for the next 14 days. Here too, whilst our ships are still able to discharge and load cargo, movement of cargo and containers in & out of this zone are still restricted until the expiry of the quarantine period on the 17th of April.

We remain at your service to find solutions to keep your cargo moving and our local logistics and international shipping services operational. We will keep you informed as the situation develops. Please contact our local representative Pacific Forum Line Fiji Agencies for any further information. Our offices remain open as essential services, with the necessary precautions in place for our staff.
