

NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS – AUSPAC SERVICE

Further to our schedule announcements, Pacific Forum Line is pleased to announce new arrangements for the AUSPAC service from Australia to the Pacific Islands, as well as the AUSPAC service between the Pacific Islands.

In a chartering and slot sale deal with CNCo, Pacific Forum Line and Neptune Pacific Line respectively have chartered Miho class vessels to sail in the AUSPAC trade servicing the island markets of New Caledonia, Vanuatu, Fiji, Samoa, and Kingdom Of Tonga, from Australia.

The first vessel, chartered by Pacific Forum Line to be named the Forum Samoa 4 will arrive Melbourne on 18th of February.

The Melanesian Pride, chartered by Neptune Pacific Line, will commence service from Melbourne on the 6th of March.

These arrangements will provide sufficient capacity to meet the trade requirements with the vessels having the service speed to ensure schedule reliability.
