Re: Capitaine Dampier 159N Blank Sailing

Dear Valued Customers,

Pacific Forum Line (PFL) wishes to advise the Capitaine Dampier 158S has experienced some mechanical difficulties and is currently sitting in Suva awaiting spare parts.

Due to the Covid-19 situation and travel restrictions we are unable to fly in a replacement part, however have spares available on the Dampier's sister ship, Capitaine Tasman which is scheduled to arrive Suva 3rd April.

In lieu of above the following arrangements will take place;

- All Tauranga cargo booked on Capitaine Dampier 159N will be now load on the Capitaine Tasman 026N ETD Tauranga 14th April 2020.
- The Southern Lily 471N will perform her scheduled voyage into Nuku'alofa, Pago Pago and Apia then proceed to Suva and Lautoka. Some cargo ex Auckland to Fiji booked for the Capitaine Dampier will load on the Southern Lily.
- Any remaining cargo ex Auckland, booked for the Capitaine Dampier v 159, that does not load on the Southern Lily will load on the Capitaine Tasman v26n.
- We will be issuing updated and forwarded schedules within 1st April 2020

Due to the unexpected issues with Capitaine Dampier 158S, we will now have voyage 159N as the bank sailing instead of the previously advised Capitaine Dampier 160N.
