Dear Valued Customers,

As per our earlier advise, category 5 TC Harold is expected to pass through the region tomorrow, from Tuesday 1200 the port will cease all operations and both Lautoka and Suva will be closed by 1700 – this until the Cyclone has passed.

On basis of above, in order to protect / regain the Capitaine Tasman schedule, the vessel has completed Suva operations and will omit the direct port call of Lautoka instead head southbound back to Tauranga where she will pick up her scheduled position to commence 026N in Tauranga 10th April.

The Capitaine Tasman 025N Lautoka import and export cargo plan is as follows:

1. Lautoka imports currently booked on 025N will stay on board and be discharged on voyage 026N.
2. Lautoka export cargo booked for Capitaine Tasman 025S, will now be loaded on the Capitaine Dampier 158S
