Australia to Pacific Islands Rate Adjustment

Dear Valued Customers,

The global shipping industry continues to experience unprecedented challenges, amplified by the difficulties caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. As a result, we've incurred several increased costs to operate our business including a dramatic increase in ship prices, charter rates and container costs due to global shortages. Port congestion continues to impact capacity and scheduling and our pursuit to maintain the health and safety of our crew members comes at a high, yet necessary cost.

Despite our best effort to minimize this impact on your business, we have made the difficult decision to increase our ocean rates to remain competitive and to sustain the scope and frequency of our services that you expect from Pacific Forum Line.

Effective for cargo loaded onboard vessels on or after 25th of July 2021, rates will be adjusted at the levels below:
